Focus on the Finish

How easily distracted we get! We commit to spending time reading our Bible, praying, and serving the Lord, but when the phone rings, the baby cries, or life just happens, how do we stick to our commitment? Before you know it, days have passed since the Bible was last opened, or our knees have knelt in prayer. Jesus was the expert in managing multiple demands and yet staying focused on God. Join Deedy in exploring ways to battle the distractions of life and find the solutions in the truths of God's word.

Stormy Praises

Have you ever found yourself in the midst of a difficult time and wondered, "Where are you God?" Or have you ever prayed and felt your prayers were bouncing off the ceiling and getting nowhere? Deedy will share with you the answers she found during the "storms" in her life, and will give you the tools to get through your "stormy" situations with "praise" on your lips. (This topic can be presented as a single session but is a wonderful option for multiple sessions.)

Chasing Away the Birds of Prey: Holding on to the Promises of God

Why is it we start out serving the Lord with gusto and before long feel ourselves fizzling out? We want to be faithful and one day hear Him say, "Well done My good and faithful servant," but how often we feel we've fallen short! "Is this how it is for others, or is it just me?" we may ask ourselves. Our service may be in the church, volunteering in our community, working at our jobs, or most importantly, raising our families.
